COOKIE POLICY

Information about our use of cookies

The AHR website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

AHR Group Limited is part of a group of different legal entities which includes AHR Group Limited itself, AHR Management Services LLP, AHR Building Consultancy Ltd, AHR London Ltd, PCKO Ltd, AHR Architects Ltd, AHR Architects Sp. z.o.o, ZAO AHR and AHR Kazakhstan LLP. This Policy is issued on behalf of the AHR Group, with AHR Group Limited being the data controller.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website (should we introduce such an area).
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. They also collect information about the browser and operating systems of visitors. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website.
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

COOKIE NAME	EXPIRY	PURPOSE
_ga	2 years	Used to distinguish users.
_gid	24 hours	Used to distinguish users.
_gat	1 minute	Used to throttle request rate.
AMP_TOKEN	30 seconds to 1 year	Contains a token that can be used to retrieve a Client ID from AMP Client ID service. Other possible values indicate opt-out, inflight request or an error retrieving a Client ID from AMP Client ID service.
gac<property-id>	90 days	Contains campaign related information for the user.
ASP.NET_SessionID	On exit of browser	Necessary for site functionality.

You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site.
